Directions to the venue:

Coming on Rte. 1 South (From NY or North Jersey):

From Rte. 1 South, make right on South Middlebush Road. Pass Rte. 27. Follow South Middlebush Road.

At T-junction make a right on Amwell Road. Pass Demott Lane light.

Make left at Samson G Smith school after Hindu Temple.

Coming on Rte. 1 North (From South Jersey or Pennsylvania):

From Rte. 1 North make a right on Sand Hill Road Pass Rte. 27. Follow South Middlebush Road.

At T-junction, make a right on Amwell Road. Pass Demott Lane light.

Make left at Samson G Smith school after Hindu Temple.

Coming on Route 287

Take the Exit 10/Easton Ave to **S Bound Brook/New Brunswick**. Continue on Easton Ave.

Take right at light on Cedar Grove Lane. Make a left on Amwell Road. Pass Demott Lane light.

Make a left at Samson G. Smith School after Hindu Temple.
